More delegations on herbicide use. Of note:

In light of delegations advocating both for and against the use of herbicides, Chair Smith reminded members of the Committee that Council has passed a resolution prohibiting Hydro One from using Garlon within the municipality. He explained that if nothing is done, this past resolution will stand and staff will communicate this resolution to Hydro One. Given that the resolution applies only to Hydro One, the Committee discussed the option of making the resolution broader to capture all Garlon users and ensure that the herbicide is only applied when deemed necessary. With many altered shorelines and soil with lower clay content in the municipality, the Committee agreed that a Dysart-specific solution might be appropriate.
